True meaning of Memorial Day remembered at county service

Anson County annual Memorial Day service, held Saturday, May 23 on the courthouse steps, brought home the point again and again that the holiday is more than the start to the summer season. It meant to be a remembrance of the servicemen and women who gave their lives for their country.

Veterans Services Director Theodore Ward started off the ceremony by reminding those present, õKeep in mind, freedom isnæt free.ö

Sheriff Landric Reid, who is also an Army veteran, gave the welcome address. õThis is the day we give thanks for those who have paid the ultimate price, ö he said. õThis is a very importance service for those who have given their lives in defense of the greatest country in the world.ö

Commissioner Jarvis Woodburn was the speaker for the ceremony, and Ward called him õa very humble man.ö Woodburn was born and raised in Anson County, and is a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps and the Vietnam War.

Woodburn told the story of three kids growing up in Anson County who were trying to decide what to do with their lives. All three joined the military. õOne had a successful military career and is retired and living out of state,ö he said. õOne stands before you and the other is on the memorial over there.ö

The memorial is to the far right of the courthouse steps, and lists the name of every Anson County citizen who was killed in World War I, World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War.

After Woodburn speech, the HOLLA! students read the names of every Ansonian killed in battle, from World War I, World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War.

A moment of silence was held to honor the families of deceased veterans, and Army veteran Jacqueline Rubio laid a wreath in front of the war memorial to

a recorded rendition of TAPS.

As the service ended, Ward said, õLetos not let



the importance of Memorial Day slip our minds this weekend.ö
