Gibson named as Gov. Perdue's senior advisor!

Rep. Pryor Gibson, who represents



Anson and Union counties in the N.C. General Assembly, will be giving up his seat in the House of Representatives to serve as Governor Bev Perdue's senior adviser for

governmental affairs. The announcement was made by Gov. Perdue.

Gibson is in his eighth term and has held a variety of leadership posts, including co-chair of the House Finance Committee. He has a longstanding reputation for building relationships with all members of the General Assembly.

"I am excited by the opportunity and humbled by it," Gibson said in a phone interview. "I look forward to helping transition the process for my replacement, whomever that may be." Gibson, who is a native of Anson County, released the following statement: "Representing this community has been and always will be the most important part of my public service life. I am honored, challenged and humbled by the new opportunity.

There is a standard process for finding a replacement for an outgoing member's House seat, he said. Committees within the Democratic parties in Anson and Union counties will meet and decide on a nominee. who will then be appointed by the governor.

Gibson will move into his new role when a successor has been named for his House seat.
